

Fire Evacuation Plan 2024-2025

Bedford Kindergarten

Purpose:

The safety of all children, staff, and visitors at Bedford Kindergarten is our top priority. This fire evacuation plan outlines the procedures to be followed in the event of a fire to ensure the safe and orderly evacuation of the premises.

Evacuation Procedures

1. Alarm Activation

- If a fire is detected, the nearest fire alarm should be activated immediately.
- The alarm system will alert everyone in the building to evacuate.

2. Evacuation Routes

- All classrooms, library, clinic, playroom, offices, and activity areas have clearly marked exit routes.
- Teachers and staff must lead children to the nearest safe exit promptly and orderly.

3. Assembly Points

- Designated assembly points are located in the open area **outside the main entrance**, safely away from the building.
- Staff must ensure children are gathered and accounted for at these points.

5. Responsibilities

• Teachers/Assistants:

- Take the attendance register before evacuation and bring it to the assembly point.
- Guide children calmly and avoid panic.
- Conduct a headcount at the assembly point.

Admin Staff:

• Check common areas, restrooms, and staff rooms to ensure everyone has evacuated.

• Evacuation Warden (Designated Staff by the principal):

- Coordinate the evacuation process.
- Ensure no one re-enters the building until clearance is given by emergency services.

• Management:

- ❖ Contact emergency services immediately (999).
- ❖ Liaise with emergency responders and provide necessary information.

6. Special Considerations

- Children with mobility challenges or special needs will be assisted by assigned staff members.
- A dedicated buddy system will be in place for ensuring their safety.

7. Fire Equipment Locations

• Five Fire extinguishers, and alarms are strategically placed throughout the building. Staff must familiarize themselves with these locations.

Post-Evacuation Procedures

- Conduct a final headcount and ensure all individuals are safe and accounted for.
- Wait for instructions from emergency services before returning to the building.
- Notify parents/guardians immediately after ensuring everyone's safety.

Fire Drills

- Fire drills will be conducted every term to familiarize staff and children with evacuation procedures.
- Drills will be evaluated for efficiency, and necessary improvements will be implemented.

Key Points to Remember

- Remain calm and act swiftly.
- Never re-enter the building for personal belongings.
- Follow the designated evacuation routes.

This plan will be reviewed and updated regularly to ensure its effectiveness and compliance with local safety regulations.
