Parking Guidelines:

• Drop-off/Pick-up Zone: A designated area near the entrance is allocated for drop-off and pick-up. This zone is clearly marked and easily accessible, allowing parents to quickly drop off or pick up their children without causing congestion.

- Separate Parking Slots- The parking slots are clearly marked, and buses are permitted to load and unload one at a time. This area is safely distanced from pedestrian traffic.

 visitors, and parents who need to park for longer periods. These
 spaces are conveniently located but separated from the drop-off/pick-up zone to avoid congestion.
- Safety Measures: Speed bumps, traffic signs, and crosswalks are installed to ensure pedestrian safety, particularly for children. Bright colors and clear signage help make drivers aware of their surroundings.
- Clear Signage: Signs clearly indicate parking areas, drop-off/pick-up zones, and other important locations to ensure easy navigation.
- Regular Maintenance: We maintain the parking area regularly, repairing any damages, repainting lines, and keeping the area clean and free of debris.
- Feedback and Improvement: Feedback from parents, staff, and visitors
 regarding the parking plan is encouraged. We regularly assess the
 plan's effectiveness and make improvements as needed to ensure
 smooth traffic flow and safety.

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Guidelines for Parents and Visitors:

- Park your vehicle in an orderly manner outside the premises and walk to the kindergarten.
- Keep your speed low when approaching the school.
- Turn off your engine if you are leaving your vehicle.
- Keep the school gates clear at all times. Stopping here, even briefly, is dangerous.
- Avoid parking in the residents' car park across the road or blocking their driveways.
- Leave enough room in the middle of the road for other vehicles to pass easily.
- Ensure emergency vehicles can access the school if necessary.
- Help your child leave and enter your vehicle safely from the pavement side.
- Do not double park.
- Avoid parking on the pedestrian crossing.
- Exercise caution when reversing.

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
