- **Ensure Homework is Returned**: Help your child remember to bring all completed assignments back each Monday.

- Use a Pencil: Remind your child to use a pencil for easy corrections.
- **Gentle Reminders**: Give your child a little nudge to help them stay on track with returning homework.
