Introduction

At Bedford Kindergarten, we believe in the importance of maintaining a consistent school uniform policy. All children are expected to wear the designated school uniform during school hours and when participating in school-organized events outside of regular hours. - Teaches children to express themselves in ways other than through clothing or material possessions.

Jewellery

Girls are permitted to wear only one pair of earrings. If a child arrives at school wearing more than one pair, they will be asked to remove the extra jewellery. However, staff are neither expected nor permitted to remove any jewellery from a child. This responsibility rests solely with the parent or carer. Bedford Kindergarten staff will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for the safekeeping or loss of any jewellery worn by children.

The Role of Parents

We ask parents to fully support Bedford Kindergarten's uniform policy. Children should attend school in the appropriate uniform daily, unless there is a special event such as a dress-up or activity day.

Parents are also required to pack an extra set of clothing in their child's backpack in case the uniform becomes soiled during the school day. Spare clothing should be clean and well-maintained. Please ensure all your child's clothing is clearly labelled. Unlabelled and unclaimed items may be considered property of the school and either donated or disposed of.

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
